

Escape to Guides FAQ's

Q. Why do the brownies have to be aged 9 or over by the 27 July 2018?
A. This is so that they will be the correct age to attend Charnwood 2019 - we don't want to build expectations and then find they are not old enough

Q. Where will the girls be sleeping?
A. All girls will be sleeping with their leaders in a marquee

Q. What is the ratio of adults/brownies
A. 1:6, (OVER 18's) Young leaders do not count in the ratios

Q. I don't have a camp licence can I still bring my girls?
A. Yes! There will be lots of experienced/qualified leaders on site to help you

Q. I won't have enough adults to accompany my girls can they still come?
A. Yes, let us know and we will buddy you up with another unit

Q. What will the girls be doing?
A. They will have the chance to experience a large-scale camp to encourage them to move on the Guides and look forward to attending Charnwood 2019. Take part in a wide range of activities and complete Brownies Go for it!

Q. What do they need to bring?
A. A full kit list will be sent nearer the time, everyone will need a packed lunch for Wednesday and a sleeping bag.

Q. What forms do I need to complete?
A. All units will need to complete REN form - this will be sent to you on booking for you to add your own details.
A kit list and health form will also be sent to you nearer the camp

Q. What else do I need to do/bring?
A. You will need to arrange your own home contact, and bring a small first aid kit, - the camp will be able to help with more serious injuries
