Chalet

Fully equipped timber chalet for self catering holidays



Kitchen

The kitchen includes: Fridge and freezer, catering size gas cooker, toaster, urn and a small microwave oven.

There is also an electric kettle, food storage cupboards, heated cupboards, crockery, cutlery and cooking and serving equipment.

The dining area has four tables and benches seating a maximum of 32.

There is a night storage heater for winter use

Main Hall

The main hall gives sufficient space for activities and sleeping.

There is an open fireplace, a fully fitted carpet and double glazing. There are four convector heaters which may be used overnight with no noise.

The sleeping area has 24 camp beds and blankets but you will need to bring your own sleeping bags and pillows.

There is a variety of games including table tennis, giant connect 4, giant Jenga and a dressing up box

Leaders Room

Sleeps 4 in one set of bunk beds and 2 single beds. Each with blanket and pillow. You need to bring your own sleeping bag and pillow case.

There is a telephone and small TV (with Licence) and CD player if required.

Activity Room

A multi purpose room equipped with tables chairs and ample plug sockets. The Fire exit from this room opens on to the campsites

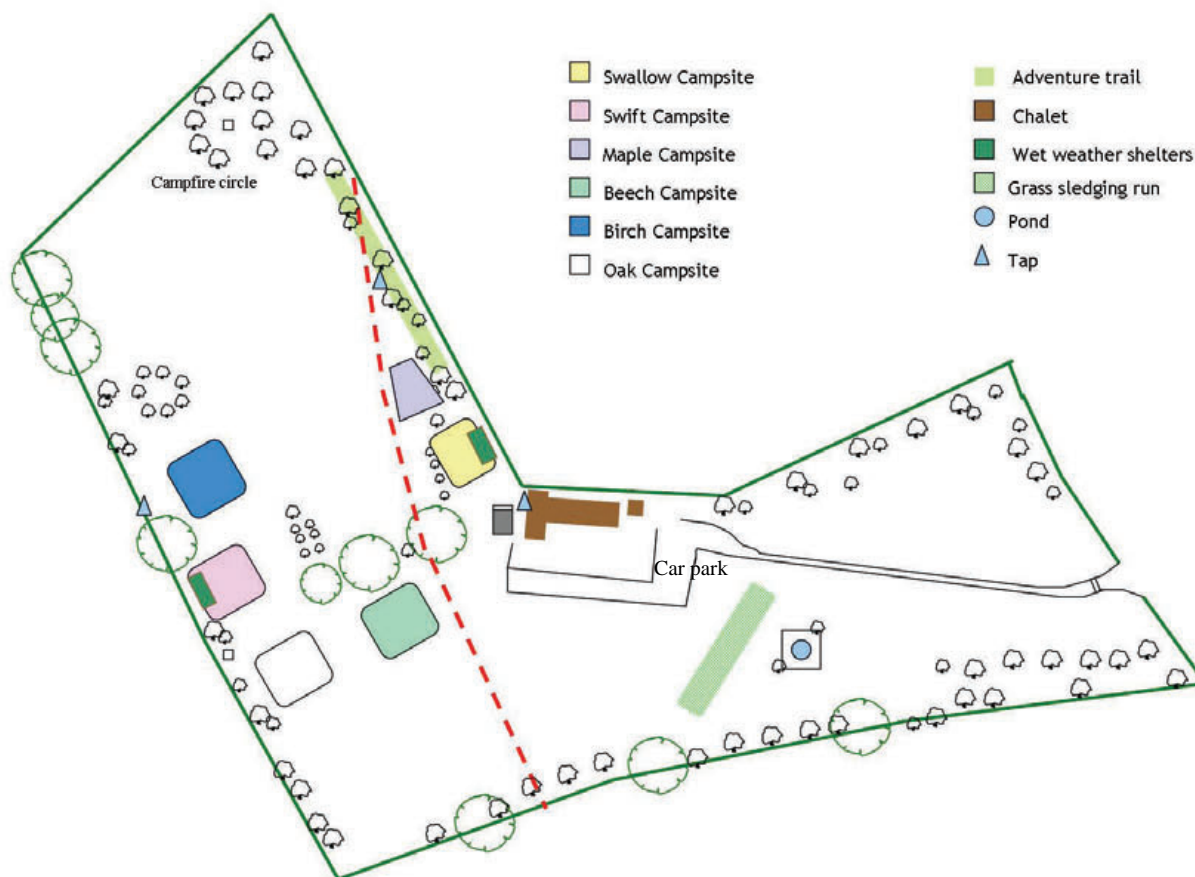
Washing facilities

There are four hand wash basins, two showers and three toilets. You will need to bring your own cleaning equipment

There is a separate wheelchair access toilet/shower room

General information

Parking

There is a car park at the end of the drive. Cars are permitted onto the tarmac play area and campsites to unload but must be moved to car park as soon as practical.

Souvenirs

These can be on sale by arrangement. There is an interesting range of pocket money gifts, badges and sweets. Janet Mills usually telephones the chalet on a Friday evening to see if this service is required

Water

The water is metered and drains into a cess pit so please use sparingly

Refuse

All non recyclable waste should be bagged and tied and placed in the 2 industrial wheelie bins that are situated by the garage. If the bins are full please leave bagged and tied rubbish in the garage away from foxes who enjoy spreading it all over the campsite!

Recycling

Bins are provided for the collection of glass, plastic bottles, washed and flattened cans and paper and card.

Horses
